Your First Appointment

We ask that you arrive for your first appointment 10 minutes early if you have not completed the attached paperwork. Please plan to be in our office for 1-3 hours for the first visit. This will allow time for registration, a comprehensive history, pupil dilation, the doctor's exam, and any testing that you may require.

In order to make your visit move quickly, we also ask that you bring the following:

- Completed patient forms enclosed
 Insurance cards, co-pay, and referral, if required
- Prescription glasses if you wear them
 A light snack if you are diabetic
 A translator/interpreter if needed

Pupil dilation gives the doctor a better view inside your eye. Your vision will be blurred, and you may be sensitive to light for 4 to 6 hours afterwards. Therefore, we recommend that you bring sunglasses and have

someone drive you home after your appointment. you know that you cannot keep an appointment, please notify us at least 48 hours in advance so that others may be given the opportunity to be seen by the
